7. Boat Usage

- The boat may only be used within the Blekinge archipelago.
- The renter may not hire the boat out to another party.
- The renter may not transport persons for pay.
- A maximum of 10 adults allowed aboard Klaura
- A maximum of 2 adults and 1 child in Camilla.

8. Responsibilities of the Renter

The renter is responsible for being sufficiently knowledgeable about boats, navigation, sailing and regulations on giving way in order to be able to operate and take care of the boat. The renter must also be knowledgeable about how a spritsail boat is rigged and sailed. The renter is responsible for ensuring that there are life jackets aboard.

The renter may resort to a third party possessing the aforementioned skills, but the renter remains responsible for ensuring that the boat is operated and cared for in the proper manner. If the renter elects to resort to a third person, the lessor shall be informed.

9. Insurance

The lessor is responsible for ensuring that the boat and its accessory are fully insured by a policy with Länsförsäkringar subject to an excess (deductible) of 10% of the applicable base amount, (carelessness at sea, collision with another boat etc.). With regard to the property insurance policy, the excess (deductible) is a fixed amount of SEK 1500. The terms and scope of the policy are set out in the copy of the insurance policy having been provided by the lessor.

10. Transfer of Contract

The renter is not entitled to transfer the rental contract to another party.

11. Maintenance

The renter is responsible for ensuring that during the rental period, the boat is well cared for, and he is responsible for following the lessor's instructions concerning boat maintenance. If the renter handles the boat carelessly or if it is poorly maintained such that it poses a considerable risk of a substantial devaluation occurring, the lessor shall be entitled to assess the cost of damages and to invoice the renter for such costs.

12. Measures in the Event of Defects, Damage and Loss

Should defects or damage occur to the boat or accessories, as well the loss of a boat or accessories, it shall be incumbent upon the renter as soon as possible to notify the lessor. After investigating such a matter, the lessor shall notify the renter without delay as to what measures will be taken.

13. The Renter's Liability in the Event of Damage and Loss

To the extent that loss or damage to a boat or its accessories is not covered by such an insurance policy as set out in Section 9, the renter shall be liable to compensate such loss or damage. If the loss or damage is covered by the insurance policy, the renter shall be liable to pay the excess (deductible).

14. Cancellation

Cancellations can be made at no cost up to four weeks prior to the booking date. Cancellations made subsequent to that are subject to a 50% fee. If a cancellation is made on the day prior to or on the very day of the booking date, the full price is charged. If the boat is cancelled on the day prior to or on the very booking date due to inclement weather, no price is charged. If inclement weather occurs during a rental period in progress, the museum will not pay back any portion of the rent.

15. Return of Boat upon the End of the Rental Period etc.

At the end of the rental period, the renter shall return the boat to the location where it was collected, unless the parties have agreed to some other location. The boat must be returned well-tidied and in the same condition as when it was collected.

If the renter is unable to return the boat according to the agreement, he must immediately contact the lessor. If the lessor does not consent to extending the rental period or consent to having the boat returned somewhere other than the agreed location, the renter shall pay a penalty of SEK 2000 for each day or part thereof that the delay persists. The penalty fee is due for payment immediately and the lessor is entitled to interest according to law for any late payment. Responsibility for the boat is transferred to the lessor once the boat has been returned to the return location as set out in Section 6.

16. In an emergency/unsafe situation, always dial 112

For preventive response, call the Swedish Sea Rescue Service. 0200-29 00 90 If you are a member of the Swedish Sea Rescue Service, it will cost you nothing. If you are not a member and you receive assistance from the Swedish Sea Rescue Service. The renter pays, on site, the applicable membership fee to the Swedish Sea Rescue Service (in 2018: SEK 800. 17. Measures in the Event of Defects, Damage or Loss

If during the rental period some defect occurs to the boat or equipment, wreck, fire or theft of the boat or of loose equipment, the lessor shall immediately be notified, and his instructions followed. The renter is entitled to recover from the lessor those costs incurred to repair such faults and defects for which the lessor is liable. However, the renter must first obtain express permission from the lessor to carry out the repair, as well as the latter's approval of the cost. Compensation is only paid upon the presentation of a register receipt. However, if the lessor or his representative cannot be reached for a period of more than 24 hours after the damage occurs and a repair for which the lessor is liable is necessary in order for the boat to continue to be used, the renter shall be free to have such a repair carried out at the lessor's expense. Lost equipment is compensated for and charged according to the price list.

18. Personal Injury and Property Damage

The lessor cannot be held liable for any personal injury or property damage that occurs to another party's property during the rental period.

19. Disputes

Disputes concerning the interpretation or application of these conditions shall be resolved, as a first resort, through voluntary agreement. If the parties cannot reach an agreement, the dispute shall be resolved by the District Court in accordance with Swedish law.
